Letter from our founder

As we embark on a New Year, I have never been more excited about the opportunity to shape the future.

Our world is going through a number of global geopolitical and localized shifts, but we cannot allow those to distract us from the primary imperative of pushing forward on the frontlines of change.

I still firmly hold to the belief that venture building and entrepreneurship will surface the leaders who will transform Africa's future. The task therefore of laying the foundations and pathways to surface those leaders is critically important and is the basis of our work at Impact Africa Network.

The vision that draws us irresistibly forward is anchored in our **10 10 10 plan**. The goal is to develop 10 scale ups, that provide 10k jobs, with a combined value of \$10B as a portfolio by 2030.

We call it the **1000 Lee Kuan Yews**, fashioned after the founding father of Singapore of the same name who I consider as **statesman-entrepreneur** of the 20th century.

A veritable force of nature, Lee Kuan Yew is the only post colonial leader to take a country from 3rd world to 1st in a single generation. Laying the blueprint that inspired many leaders including Mao Zedong of China and Paul Kagame of Rwanda





Lokal Capital is a community-based venture capital model designed to enable local investors participate in transformative local innovations.






Today's youth face a multifaceted challenge: a lack of financial knowledge, absence of a supportive community in their success journey, and the absence of tools to set them up for success.

My skills have been sculpted in ways I never imagined, thanks to the invigorating learning curve. Not only has my design ability grown exponentially, but how I marry it to business objectives.



Africans living in the diaspora have a strong desire to invest in real estate in their home countries but struggle due to lack of reliable service providers.


As of 2020, approximately 19.5 million Africans reside in different countries abroad. Despite their global presence, they share a common challenge: the arduous task of investing in the African property market..

With Roots Africa, we are on a mission to empower Africans living in the diaspora to navigate the African property market and participate in Africa's economic growth from wherever they are.






























Overview of the Shukran tipping app interface


Kinetic is an Ed-tech platform providing entrepreneurship skills to high school students.




LAUNCHPAD INNOVATION CAMPUS



























VENTURE CAPITAL

Recognizing the uniqueness of African markets, the focus shifted to identifying startups earning fundraising opportunities through genuine value creation rather than inflated valuations.









This vision, encapsulated as the '1000 Lee Kuan Yews', is inspired by the remarkable legacy of Singapore's founding father.


