
INNOVATION FELLOWSHIPS

We provide 12 month Innovation Fellowships to talented college graduates giving them the opportunity to work on well vetted ideas; with like minded peers; under the guidance of an experienced leadership team and mentor network.

The goal is to expand entrepreneurial capacity while at the same time developing fundamentally sound early stage startups.

In 2019, we provided Innovation Fellowship opportunities to 15 talented young people in Nairobi.

The fellows were involved in multiple projects including establishing the IAN brand, launching our podcast, kick starting the Innovation Studio, talent development and hosting two ecosystem events.
